

Engleka, Paul, Yost Personal Finance Scholarship • 2023

We would like to welcome any Berlin senior to submit an application for the 2023 *Engleka, Paul, Yost Personal Finance Scholarship*. Any student graduating this spring, regardless of their post graduation plans, is eligible to apply for this scholarship. This is a **\$1,000 scholarship that can be used however the winner sees fit**. This scholarship was created with the purpose of bringing to light the importance of personal finance and why it is not only important to oneself, but to a community.

Students must submit the following:

1. Application
 - a. The application includes contact information, as well as questions regarding the applicant's future plans, school and community involvement, and employment history.
2. Essay (**No set word limit or requirement**)
 - a. There are many facets to having a healthy life. The most common forms of health are physical, emotional, spiritual, and social. There is another form of health that is not so common, which is financial health. Please explain what financial health is, how to get there, and why being financially healthy correlates with the other areas of health.

Scholarship applications can be turned in or emailed to the high school guidance office or to Mr. Turner Paul. To remove any potential bias, applications will be given a number in place of the applicant's name, before being looked over for consideration by our selection committee. The scholarship will be awarded based on the individual's application and primarily the answer given in their essay.

The scholarship will be awarded at the high school awards day ceremony. We ask that the winner agree to a photo after the ceremony, so we may congratulate them through our social media account. The scholarship will be issued as a check written out to the individual and we recommend it be used for things such as furthering education, job or business startup, investing, or charity. By awarding an individual this scholarship, we believe the recipient has displayed an understanding of the importance of personal finance and therefore, can be trusted to use this money in a responsible and positive way.
